

The "Harry Secombe Cup" is awarded to the top House taking account of school activities as a whole: academic work, rugby, soccer, athletics and the Hobbies Exhibition.

#### 1883 - 1958.

- 1883. Swansea Higher Grade School, Trinity Place. First Headmaster: Mr. Gomer Jones, B.A.
- 1884. Mr. Samuel Roberts, B.A., appointed Headmaster.
- 1894. The School moved to Dynevor Place.
- 1896. A change of name to "Swansea Higher Elementary School."
- 1908. Became the "Swansea Municipal Secondary School."
- 1910. Mr. Samuel Roberts resigned after 26 years as Headmaster.
- 1911. Mr. W. A. BEANLAND, B.A., became Headmaster.
- 1929. Mr. Llewelyn John B.Sc., appointed Headmaster on the resignation of Mr. Beanland.
  - The Old Boys' Association was formed with Mr. Beanland as first President.
  - The School moved into its new buildings and shortly became known as "Dynevor School."
- 1941. Partial destruction of the School in the Blitz.
- 1942. Mr. W. Bryn Thomas, M.A., became Headmaster on the resignation of Mr. John.
- 1952. Mr. GLAN POWELL, B.A., became Headmaster on the resignation of Mr. Thomas.
- 1957. A major project of restoration and reconstruction was begun at the School.
  - Mr. Meredydd G. Hughes became Headmaster on the resignation of Mr. Powell.
- 1958. 75th Anniversary Celebrations.
